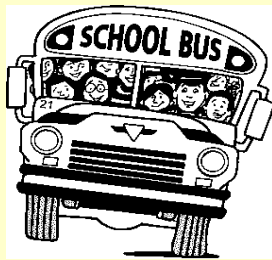
Aces

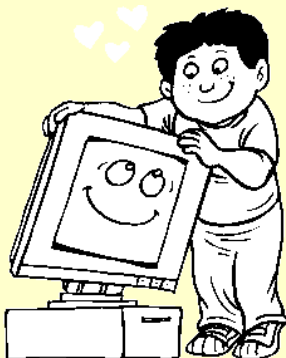

Learning Journey to our Neighbourhood

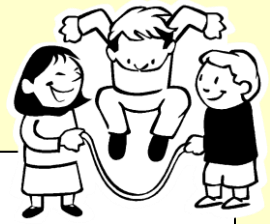

The school is having e-Learning Day on Wednesday, **22nd August 2012**. The purpose of instituting an e-Learning day is to stress test the systems that have been set up to ensure minimal interruption to our teaching functions in the event of a major disruption, for example during a pandemic where teachers and pupils may be required to stay away from school. It also aims to familiarize pupils with the online learning tools provided by our LMS.

Pupils will not report to school that day. They are expected to complete all online tasks assigned to them by the teachers via the school LMS portal from home (http://lms.asknlearn.com/frontier_ps/). Special arrangements will be made for pupils who do not have access to computing devices or Internet from home. More details will be provided at a later date

Kindly make the necessary transport arrangements to pick your child from school. Pupils are also not expected to purchase expensive gifts for their teachers. Pupils can show their appreciation more than sufficiently through a handmade card or crafts.

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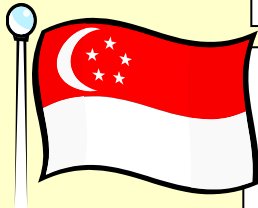
Announcements

ECHA@FPS (Edusave CHAracter Award by MOE)

To support the goal of nurturing a stronger Singapore through student-centric and values-driven education, MOE announced in March 2012 that it will restructure the Edusave awards and recognise students who demonstrate exemplary values and civic responsibility. Frontierers who are Singapore Citizens are eligible for these awards. The process of identifying pupils for these awards would come under the school's character development framework, specifically ECHA@FPS. ECHA@FPS recognizes outstanding Frontierers who are exemplary in character, and who can be role models to inspire others. While we only have P1s in our midst, we believe in moulding the character of our students from young. Hence, we have programmes planned and integrated across curriculum; and some of these include our weekly Lessons on Value Education (LOVE), student leadership programmes, Photography and Nurture through Nature sessions. The award will be given to deserving students who demonstrate (1) school values and character traits that we strongly encourage, (2) a high level of civic responsibility and (3) qualities associated with resilience. A structured selection criteria and process has been put in place to ensure its rigor and fairness. More details will be released towards the end of the year.

P1 Registration

The Phase 2C P1 Registration has just concluded and Frontier Primary has received strong support from the community. The number of applicants for places in P1 is 271. It is the highest nationwide for the first day of Phase 2C P1 Registration. Balloting will take place on 7 August 2012 to determine the successful pupils for the P1 class of 2013. We like to thank all our stakeholders and parents for helping the school to become a strong school dedicated to the education of our children.
