School Rules On Dressing

As we begin term 3, we like to remind all pupils that they need to be neat and tidy in appearance. Our school rules state that:

- Pupils are to wear the prescribed school uniform and any modification to the school uniform is not allowed.
- The name tags must be securely ironed and stitched on the top left of the PE attire above the school logo at all times.
- Pupils are not to wear jewellery or ornaments.
- Boys must be clean shaven. Hair must be above the eyebrows, ears and at least 3 cm above the collar.
- Girls may wear only one pair of simple stud earrings in school. Fringe covering the eyebrows is to be pinned up and hair beyond shoulder-length is to be tied neatly. Only black hair accessories are allowed.
- All pupils must keep their hair neat and in its natural colour.

The Green Carpet Award recognizes the achievements in nature photography and journalism of Singaporean pupils. Its aim is to inspire passion and appreciation of nature and the environment, and show how better management of personal waste and resources can help keep our environment clean. 40 P1 and P2 pupils were taken on an adventure trail to Sungei Buloh Nature Reserve by an experienced guide, accompanied by our school teachers. They used their cameras to take interesting shots of nature along the trail.

Sony Creative Science Award 2013

Trekathon 2013

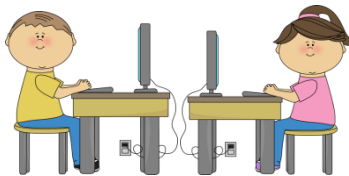
