KEY FEATURES

Learning through:

- Two flagship programmes: HI-Light Programme and Starlight Literacy Programme for English and Mother Tongue Language
- Activities organised around four broad themes set within the local context
- Activities with a distinctive Singapore flavour
- Weeks of Wonder (WoW) projects which encourage self-motivated learning through exploration and discovery



HI-LIGHT PROGRAMME

Designed to support children's Holistic development through an Integrated approach to learning in the following six areas:

- Discovery of the World
- Motor Skills Development
- Language and Literacy

STARLIGHT LITERACY PROGRAMME

- Nurtures early childhood bilingualism
- Offered in English and three Mother
 Tongue Languages (Chinese, Malay and
 Tamil)
- Focuses on developing listening, speaking and early reading and writing skills













STARLIGHT LITERACY PROGRAMME

- Uses Big Books, songs and games set in the local context to make learning fun and engaging
- Encourages families to be involved in activities to enthuse children in language learning
- Provides opportunities for children to communicate in English and their Mother Tongue Language with confidence and be aware of local traditions and customs

Comprises the Centre Head and/or Deputy Centre Head, MK Level Head, MK Lead/Senior Teacher, and teachers with a heart for children and experience in early childhood settings in Singapore

MOE Curriculum Specialists who provide professional support to the teachers through mentoring and coaching

Supportive school leadership and administrative team from the primary school

- Possess requisite competencies and skills to engage children in activities while ensuring their safety and well-being

SAFE MANAGEMENT MEASURES



KEEPING CHILDREN & STAFF SAFE

Safe Management Measures

- Mask wearing and increased number of health checks in the day
- Safe distancing as far as practicable
- Designated seating for group work
- Inculcating habits for good personal hygiene (e.g. handwashing)

MKs ensure that all prevailing Safe Management Measures required by the Early Childhood Development Agency are implemented.





A SMOOTH TRANSITION TO MK



K1 ORIENTATION

A Smooth Transition to MK

You and your child will be invited to an **orientation session** before the start of the K1 year, where you will meet with the kindergarten teachers and classmates. This session will help to familiarise your child with the new learning environment.





FIRST DAY OF TERM 1

A Smooth Transition to MK

- For the first day of Term 1, you are welcome to accompany your child to the MK to help him or her through the routines in the kindergarten subject to prevailing Safe Management Measures.
- Teachers at the MK will keep a look out for children who experience adjustment challenges and work together with the parents to support the child's transition to the new learning environment.

MK-EARLY YEARS CENTRE (EYC) COLLABORATION



MK-EYC COLLABORATION

Pilot collaboration with Anchor Operators (AOPs) on a new pre-school service model to provide a continuum of quality and affordable pre-school education for children aged two months to six years.

All Singapore Citizen (SC) and Permanent Resident (PR) Nursery 2 (N2) children enrolled in a partner PCF Sparkletots / NTUC My First Skool EYC, who meet a set of eligibility criteria* are assured of a K1 place in their partner MK.

ONLINE REGISTRATION FOR 2023 K1 ADMISSIONS

- All SC and PR children, including children registering to their partner MK via Early Years Centre (EYC) admissions* are to register online.
- Registration period from 4 February 2022 (Friday), 9am to 8 February 2022 (Tuesday), 4pm.
- Register your child at www.moe.gov.sg/mk-register
- Outside this registration period, parents can also seek admission to K1 or K2 for their child by contacting the MK directly to check if there are vacancies.

*EYC Parents who are intending to register their child in a non-partner MK should a pply via Open Admissions (OA) registration form. Your application will be considered under the MK OA registration and subject to the same conditions as all other OA applications.
