

APPLICATION TO JOIN THE PARENT VOLUNTEER SCHEME

Frontier Primary School welcomes all interested parents to apply as Parent Volunteers under the Parent Volunteer Scheme. Under this scheme, a parent may be able to register his/her child under Phase 2B of the Primary One Registration Exercise if he/she meets the following criteria:

- a) His/Her child is a Singapore Citizen or Singapore Permanent Resident;
- b) He/She has joined the school as a parent volunteer and has contributed at least 40 hours of voluntary service to the school.

Interested parents are to submit their application forms via email frontier_ps@moe.edu.sg latest on 30 April 2022. Application is only available if the child is born in 2017 i.e. he/she will participate in the Primary One Registration Exercise in 2023 and be admitted for Primary One in 2024. Please complete all sections of the application form. Late and/or incomplete forms will not be considered.
